- 3. District Manager's Report The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
- 4. Island Security The Board will discuss upcoming events, the neighborhood watch, safety, and possible criminal activity on the Island. The Board will review and possibly approve the replacement of its existing cameras.

- 5. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings The Board will review and consider the approval of the prior meeting(s).
- 6. Accounts Payable The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
- 7. Whales Belly The Board to discuss reassessing the Whales Belly parcel based on use.
- 8. Assessment Call No. 27 The Board to hear a status update.
- 9. Rules and Regulations Board to discuss and may approve amending its rules and regulations.
- 10. Encroachment Permit No. 2022-4 (PG&E D-1262 Gas Transmission Dig) Board to hear an update and discuss this PG&E project. The Board will discuss progress on the cleaning of a ditch over a pipeline.
- 11. Highway 160 Turnout Barriers Board to discuss placing barriers at the Highway turnout from Station 925+00 928+00 to prevent illegal camping and dumping. Board to review quotes and consider purchasing 340 linear feet of K-rail. The Board may also approve a licensing agreement with the landowner.
- 12. Sherman Lake Rock Slope Protection Board will hear a status update on this repair.
- 13. Pump No. 1 Discharge Pipe Replacement The Board will hear a status update on this repair.
- 14. Pump No. 3 Rehabilitation The Board will receive a status update on this project.
- 15. DWR "Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement" (expiration date is 12/31/2024) The Board will receive an update on this agreement to build several hundred acres of wetland in the western and central portion of the island in an effort to reverse subsidence, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gases. The update will include a discussion and possible action on:
 - a. Repair of perimeter berm leakage at Whale's Mouth through the construction of a bentonite cutoff wall.
 - b. Moving a drainage ditch adjacent to the Sherman Island Cross Road, the repair or replacement of several risers within Whale's Belly, the repair of several siphons, and the need for a topographic survey of the Whale's Mouth and Whale's Belly projects. Status of the maintenance contract.
 - c. A salinity plan that will coordinate wetland operations with District operations.
 - d. The Board will consider requiring the project proponent to consult with and receive approval from the District engineer before undertaking maintenance associated with this project.

- 16. Project Funding Agreement SH-17-1.1-SP (Phase I of San Joaquin River Setback Levee/Habitat Bench Multi-Benefit Project, Stations 175+00 to 199+00) The Board will hear a status update on this project. Expiration Date 06/30/2027.
- 17. Engineer's Report The Board will hear an update from the engineers regarding District activities not included as agenda items.
- 18. Superintendent's Report The Board will hear an update from the Superintendent on current District activities.
