NOTICE: This Board meeting will be open to in-person attendance. The Board proceedings are also available via teleconference, and you may still participate. If you wish to comment, please speak loud enough to be heard and your comments will be considered. Members of the public are encouraged to observe and participate in the teleconference.

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1. Roll Call of Board Members and Staff
 2. Public Comments – Any person may speak on any topic provided it is within the jurisdiction of Reclamation District 341. If a person wishes to speak on an agenda item in particular, that person may speak now, or if that person wishes to withhold comment until Board consideration of the item, please inform the Board at this time what agenda item the speaker wishes to address and the Board will solicit additional comment when that agenda item is called.

No action or discussion shall be undertaken on any item not appearing on this posted agenda, except that member of the Board or staff may briefly respond to statements made under this “Public Comment” portion of the agenda. Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § 54954.2.)

3. District Manager’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
 - a) Capital Improvements – The manager will discuss needed improvements to equipment, canals, ditches, pumps, and siphons.
 - b) District Equipment Purchase – The manager and superintendent will recommend the purchase of new District equipment. The Board may approve the purchase of such equipment.

4. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings – The Board will review and consider the approval of the prior meeting(s).
5. Accounts Payable – The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
6. Warrant Line of Credit – Board to hear a status update on the Warrant Line of Credit.
7. New Assessment - Prop 218 – Board to receive an update regarding a new District-wide assessment.
8. PG&E Birds Landing – Board to receive an update on tower demolition and the possibility of taking ownership of aggregate base material from PG&E.
9. Sherman Island Cross Road – The Board will discuss the need for ditch work and repairs adjacent to this road.
10. Pump No. 1 Repair – Board to receive an update regarding repairs to the pump.
11. HDPE Pipe Purchase – Board to discuss and consider purchasing 24-inch HDPE pipe for future siphon replacement projects.
12. Violation of District Rules and Regulations
 - a. Campos - Board to discuss grindings dumped on Campos property and recent import of fill material. The Board to receive an update on fines against Campos for violating his encroachment permit and damaging a District drainage facility.
13. Encroachment Permit No. 2024-3 (Renwick Siphon Repair) – Board to hear an update on the status of the siphon repair. The Board may authorize a new permit.
14. Encroachment Permit No. 2024-6 (Caltrans Highway 160 Repaving) – Board to hear an update and discuss and the repaving of Highway 160 from Station 878+00 – 990+00.
15. Encroachment Permit No. 2025-1 (RVWA Levee Signs) – Board to discuss and consider issuing a permit for the installation of signs along the Sacramento River.
16. Encroachment Permit No. 2025-2 (PG&E Gas Line Decommissioning) – Board to discuss the removal of various gas lines across the San Joaquin River levee.
17. Encroachment Permit No. 2025-3 (HWY 160 Broadband) – Board to discuss the installation of broadband infrastructure within the Highway 160 levee.
18. Encroachment Permit No. 2025-4 (Whale’s Mouth Siphon No. 2 HDPE Conversion) – Board to discuss and consider issuing an Encroachment Permit for the replacement of a 12-inch diameter siphon that feeds Whale’s Mouth.

19. District Spraying – Board to discuss its spraying policies and coordination with the local resource conservation districts.
20. District Emergency – Board to discuss and possibly take additional action on the emergency repairs conducted last month along Sherman Lake and the Sacramento River.
21. DWR “Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement” (expiration date is 12/31/2030) –The Board will receive an update on this agreement to build several hundred acres of wetland in the western and central portion of the island in an effort to reverse subsidence, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gases. The Board may approve a shared services agreement with RD1601. The update will include a discussion and possible action on the following items:
 - a. Whale’s Belly
 - i. Warranty Work
 - ii. Remediation Work
 - b. Whale’s Mouth
 - i. Perimeter Ditch PG&E Crossing
22. Public Entity Agreement with DWR (Sherman Lake Rock Slope Protection) - The Board will receive an update on this agreement that will reimburse the District for levee maintenance along Sherman Lake.
23. Project Funding Agreement SH-17-1.1-SP (SJR Setback Levee Project, Station 175+00 to 199+00) – The Board will hear a status update on this project. Expiration Date 06/30/2027.
24. Project Funding Agreement SH-24-1.0 SP (SJR Multi-Benefit Project, Station 330+00 – 368+00) – The Board to hear a status update on this project. Expiration 12/31/2026.
25. Engineer’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the engineers regarding District activities not included as agenda items.
26. Superintendent’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the Superintendent on current District activities.
27. Adjournment to the next regular meeting.
