Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § 54954.2.)

3. District Manager’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
 - a) Capital Improvements – The manager will discuss needed improvements to equipment, canals, ditches, pumps, and siphons.

4. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings – The Board will review and consider for approval the prior meeting(s) minutes.
5. Accounts Payable – The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
6. Assessment No. 29 and No. 1– The Board to hear an update on Assessment No. 29 and Assessment No. 1. Perla will report on her conversation with the County and whether it could collect assessments.
7. Employee Manual – Board to review and possibly approve the amended employee manual.
8. Board to discuss a landowner proposal to install electric gates at the Sherman Lake Marina. The Board will receive information on a record of survey, title report, and boundary lines.
9. No. 5 Drainage Canal Crossing – The Board will discuss a letter received from a landowner regarding the removal of a culvert.
10. No. 3/Irrigation Canal Crossing – Board to review bids and consider awarding a contract for the No. 3/Irrigation Canal Crossings project.
11. DWR Reimbursement Contract – Board to consider approval of a new reimbursement contract with DWR.
12. Blackberry Mastication – Board to receive an update on the mastication of blackberries on APN 158-0030-005.
13. Mayberry Slough Dam Siphons – The update will include a discussion and possible action on the repair/replacement of siphons.
14. PG&E Birds Landing – Board to receive an update on the needed repairs to the Cross Levee Road.

 - a. No. 2025-2 (SJR PG&E Gas Line Decommissioning) – Board to hear an update on the application package for the removal of various gas lines across the San Joaquin River levee.
 - b. No. 2025-3 (HWY 160 Broadband) – Board to hear an update on the application package for installation of fiber optic lines within Highway 160 levee.
