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1. Roll Call of Board Members and Staff
 2. Public Comments – Any person may speak on any topic provided it is within the jurisdiction of Reclamation District 341. If a person wishes to speak on an agenda item in particular, that person may speak now, or if that person wishes to withhold comment until Board consideration of the item, please inform the Board at this time what agenda item the speaker wishes to address and the Board will solicit additional comment when that agenda item is called.

No action or discussion shall be undertaken on any item not appearing on this posted agenda, except that member of the Board or staff may briefly respond to statements made under this “Public Comment” portion of the agenda. Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § stric54954.2.)

3. District Manager’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
4. Island Security - The Board will discuss upcoming events, the neighborhood watch, safety, and possible criminal activity on the Island.

5. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings – The Board will review and consider the approval of the regular meeting minutes from March 14, 2023.
6. Accounts Payable – The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
7. Engage MVP Services – Discuss and possibly approve an engagement with MVP to perform pesticide training for District staff and perform a pre-agriculture inspection audit of District records and make recommendation.
8. Board to discuss assuming ownership of the New Holland tractor.
9. Board to discuss and possibly fill the Board vacancy.
10. Board to discuss obtaining pesticide/herbicide training/licenses for all its employees.
11. Board to hear a status update on engaging in a relationship with a new insurance carrier.
12. Encroachment Permit No. 2022-4 (PG&E D-1262 Gas Transmission Dig) – Board to hear an update and discuss this PG&E project.
13. Encroachment Permit No. 2022-6 (Caltrans Highway 160 Mitigation Site) – Board to discuss this Caltrans project.
14. Encroachment Permit No. 2023-1 (Campos Levee Access Ramp) – Board to consider issuing an encroachment permit.
15. Highway 160 Turnout Barriers – Board to discuss placing barriers at the Highway turnout from Station 925+00 – 928+00 to prevent illegal camping and dumping.
16. Drainage Plan – The Board will receive an update on the Draft Drainage Plan.
17. Pump No. 3 Rehabilitation – The Board will receive a status update on this project and possibly approve the purchase of a new trash rack.
18. Project Funding Agreement SH 10-2.11 – Highway 160 Construction Work /Sacramento River Repair Project - Agreement to add a drainage system to the portion of the levee experiencing seepage problems along the Sacramento River at Stations 870+00 through 940+00. The Board will hear a status update on this project. Project Funding Agreement expiration date 06/30/2023.
19. DWR “Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement”– The Board will receive an update on this agreement to build several hundred acres of wetland in the western and central portion of the island in an effort to reverse subsidence, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gases. The update will include a discussion on moving a drainage ditch adjacent to the Sherman Island Cross Road, the repair or replacement of several risers, the repair of several siphons, and the need for a topographic survey of the Whale’s Mouth and Whale’s Belly projects. The Mitigation Funding Agreement expiration date is 12/31/2024.

20. Project Funding Agreement SH-17-1.0-SP (Phase I of San Joaquin River Setback Levee/Habitat Bench Multi-Benefit Project, Stations 175+00 to 199+00) – The Board will hear a status update on this project. Expiration Date 06/30/2023.
21. Engineer’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the engineers regarding District activities not included as agenda items.
22. Superintendent’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the Superintendent on current District activities.
23. Adjournment to the next regular meeting.
