If a person wishes to speak on an agenda item in particular, that person may speak now, or if that person wishes to withhold comment until Board consideration of the item, please inform the Board at this time what agenda item the speaker wishes to address and the Board will solicit additional comment when that agenda item is called.

No action or discussion shall be undertaken on any item not appearing on this posted agenda, except that member of the Board or staff may briefly respond to statements made under this “Public Comment” portion of the agenda. Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § stric54954.2.)

3. District Manager’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
4. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings – The Board will review and consider the approval of the prior meeting(s).

5. Accounts Payable – The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
6. Assessment Call No. 27 – The Board to hear a status update.
7. New Assessment - Prop 218 – Board to consider hiring an engineer to develop a new District-wide assessment.
8. District Office – Board to discuss and possibly approve renewing its lease for its office location.
9. Highway 160 Levee Emergency Waterside Repair – Board to receive an update on the emergency that was declared in October.
10. Aging District Equipment – Board to discuss a new contract with a consultant to apply for funding to replace aging District equipment.
11. Encroachment Permit No. 2023-02 (Dock Removal, Sta 21+00) – Board to consider an Encroachment Permit to remove a dock in Threemile Slough.
12. Sherman Lake Rock Slope Protection – The Board will hear a status update on this work.
13. Pump No. 1 Discharge Pipe Replacement – The Board will hear a status update on this repair.
14. Pump No. 3 Rehabilitation – The Board will receive a status update on this project. The update will include a discussion and possible action on:
  - a. Review quotes for the installation of a transfer switch.
  - b. Consider renting a generator to provide backup power during flood season.
  - c. Review quotes for the repair of the Pump 3B column.
15. DWR “Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement” (expiration date is 12/31/2024) – The Board will receive an update on this agreement to build several hundred acres of wetland in the western and central portion of the island in an effort to reverse subsidence, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gases. The update will include a discussion and possible action on:
  - a. Repair of perimeter berm leakage at Whale’s Mouth through the construction of a bentonite cutoff wall.
  - b. Moving a drainage ditch adjacent to the Sherman Island Cross Road, the repair or replacement of several risers within Whale’s Belly, the repair of several siphons, and the need for a topographic survey of the Whale’s Mouth and Whale’s Belly projects. Status of the maintenance contract.
  - c. An operation plan that will coordinate wetland operations with District operations.

16. Project Funding Agreement SH-17-1.1-SP (Phase I of San Joaquin River Setback Levee/Habitat Bench Multi-Benefit Project, Stations 175+00 to 199+00) – The Board will hear a status update on this project. Expiration Date 06/30/2027.
17. Engineer’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the engineers regarding District activities not included as agenda items.
18. Superintendent’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the Superintendent on current District activities.
