No action or discussion shall be undertaken on any item not appearing on this posted agenda, except that member of the Board or staff may briefly respond to statements made under this “Public Comment” portion of the agenda. Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § 54954.2.)

3. District Manager’s Report – The Board will hear an update from the District Manager on current District activities.
 - a) Capital Improvements – The manager will discuss needed improvements to equipment, canals, ditches, pumps, and siphons.
4. Review of Minutes of Prior Meetings – The Board will review and consider for approval the prior meeting(s) minutes.

5. Accounts Payable – The Board will review and consider the approval of accounts payable and transfers. A general financial update will also be provided.
6. Assessment No. 30 and No. 2– The Board to hear an update on Assessment No. 30 and Assessment No. 2. The Board will receive an update on a resolution authorizing the County to put delinquent assessments on the tax roll and filing a Board of Control claim.
7. Draft Budget – Board to review and possibly approve the draft budget for 2026-2027.
8. Board to review and possibly approve engagement letter from Croce, Sanguinetti & Vander Veen CPAs, Inc. to prepare the independent audit and special district financial transactions report for the year ended June 30, 2026.
9. Recirculation Pumps – Board to discuss the possible installation of recirculation pumps. Board to review and consider an executing a contract with Laurel Ag for the design of a pump for the Whale’s Belly.
10. Blackberry Mastication – Board to hear an update on the mastication and the relocation of a cattle fence.
11. PG&E Birds Landing – Board to receive an update on the needed repairs to the Cross Levee Road and removal of bridge over No. 2 Canal.
12. Pump No. 3 – Board to receive an update on the design of the new pump station, trash rack, and pump house.
13. December 2024 Sacramento River Erosion Emergency Repairs – The Board will discuss applying for a 401 water certification as part of the 404 permit process related to the 2024 emergency.
14. Encroachment Permits
 - a. No. 2025-3 (HWY 160 Broadband) – Board to hear an update on the application package for installation of fiber optic lines within Highway 160 levee.
 - b. No. 2026-2 (Sherman Island Marina Gates) – The Board will receive an update.

DWR “Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement” (expiration date is 12/31/2030) –The Board will receive an update on this agreement to build several hundred acres of wetland in the western and central portion of the island in an effort to reverse subsidence, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gases. Board to review bids and consider awarding a contract for the Whale’s Belly Unit 1C Siphon Repair. The update will include a discussion and possible action on the following items:
 - a. Borrow Site Development
 - b. Wetland Operations Plan
 - c. Whale’s Belly
 - d. Whale’s Mouth
 - e. Whale’s Spout
